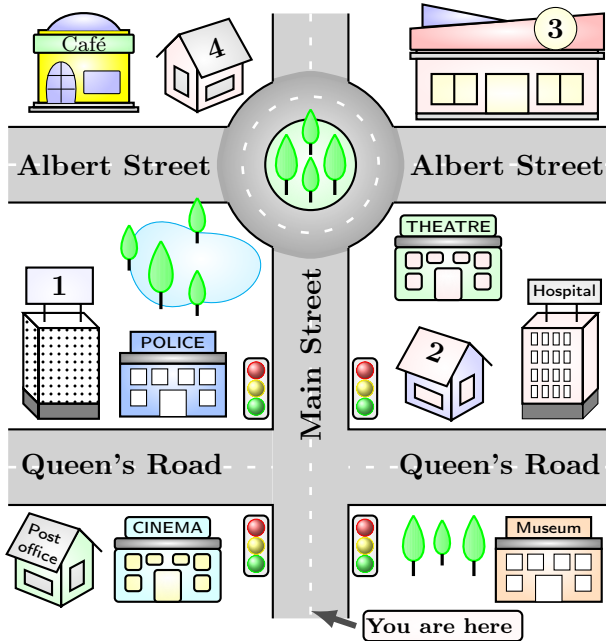


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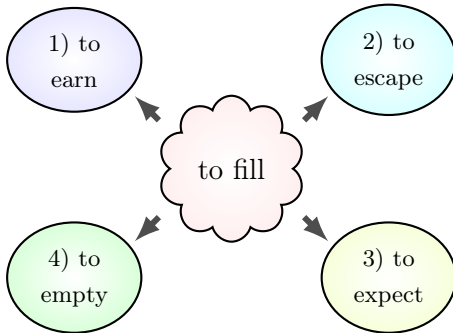

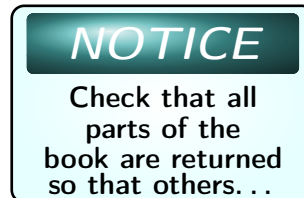

Thank you for choosing our product. Please read these instructions before use.

- Aim the thermometer at your forehead.
- Keep it vertical, about 3-5 cm away.
- Press the measurement button, a “beep” sound will be heard after about one second. Then the measurement is completed with measured degree displayed.

MAINTENANCE

- Wipe the surface with a clean soft cloth with a little medical alcohol or water.
- Keep the thermometer in places free from moisture or liquid.
- Do not leave it under overheat or low temperature environment for a long time.
- The thermometer should not be used in the sun or water.
